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The Development of Kirchberg: the INFINITY project begins

Work on INFINITY, the combined residential, offices and shops complex, has begun on the Kirchberg plateau. The prize-winning concept in the FUAK (Kirchberg Plateau Urbanisation and Development Fund) development competition in 2015 will bring fresh life to the district entrance by the end of 2019.

Added value for the Kirchberg

Work has begun on the INFINITY project to redesign the Porte de l'Europe. Earthworks and reinforcement works carried out by the Baatz-Entrapaulus consortium started in February and will go on until summer 2017. Nearly 90.000 m² of earth will be excavated. This will be followed by one of the year's biggest projects, the construction of Luxembourg's first high-rise residential building, nearly 100 metres high.

At the foot of the INFINITY triptych will be a 6,500 m² shopping centre, a vast esplanade, a 6,800 m² office building and the future Philharmonie-Mudam tram stop. "This approach fits in with FUAK's decision to create a mix of activities that bring life to the district by activating different bases containing shops and services accessible to everyone, redeveloping public spaces and creating new pedestrian links between Rue du Fort Niedergrünwald and Avenue JF Kennedy", said IMMOBEL LUXEMBOURG's CEO, Olivier Bastin.

An exceptional project

Around 200 people will be involved until late 2019 in building the 33,000-m² complex. The project includes very high-level BREEAM® "Excellent" environmental certification for the office building. With its green roof and solar panels, the developer, IMMOBEL LUXEMBOURG, has invested in a state-of-the-art operation that meets all the energy consumption management performance criteria.

Designed by Bernardo Fort-Brescia, the well-known American architect and founder of the Arquitectonica agency, in close cooperation with the Luxembourg firm M3 Architectes, the INFINITY project is an unusual shape. Built as a Möbius strip, the building's crystalline architecture will proudly match up to the great names in architecture already present in the district.

A new way of living

INFINITY LIVING is openly inspired by the luxury high-rise residential buildings in the United States. With its private concierge service, monumental reception hall and 150 high-end apartments, the INFINITY



residential tower redefines the lifestyle codes in Luxembourg. With the urban landscape as a background, the apartments offer new views over the city, even from the 6th floor, which is situated well beyond the usual top floors of the capital.

In the heart of a business district and a first-class cultural centre, with the Philharmonia, the Mudam and the Grand Theatre close by, residents will enjoy an incomparable quality of life. The INFINITY WORKING and INFINITY SHOPPING buildings are already fully reserved. The commercialisation of the INFINITY LIVING residential tower is already well underway, but several apartments of different types and prices are still available.
